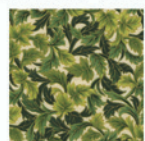

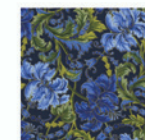

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Tuscan Wildflowers

Quilt: 48" x 48"

Pressing Template

All Seams are 1/4" – All strips are cut the width of the fabric (trim all selvages) – Seams are pressed toward arrows unless instructed otherwise

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Directions
1	Eggshell DRJ-6110-86	1-3/8 yds.	Cut 8 strips 5-1/2" wide. Cut into 36 squares 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" and 36 rectangles 2" x 5-1/2".
2	Black, Green & Gold medium print APTM-6244-203	1/2 yd.	Cut 3 strips 4-1/2" wide. Cut into 40 of Template A. 
3	Gold, Green & Cream small print APTM-6248-203	3/8 yd.	Cut 2 strips 4-1/2" wide. Cut into 20 of Template A.
4	Russet APTM-5574-180	5/8 yd.	Cut 2 strips 2-3/4" wide. Cut into 36 of Template B. Cut 4 strips 1" wide for second border. 
5	Navy, Blue & Green medium print APTM-6251-203	3/8 yd.	Cut 2 strips 4-1/2" wide. Cut into 32 of Template A.
6	Green & Cream Leaf APTM-6247-43	1/4 yd.	Cut 1 strip 4-1/2" wide. Cut into 16 of Template A.
7	Black Strip APTM-6245-203	3/8 yd.	Cut 4 strips 2" wide for the first border.
8	Black, Gold & Green large print APTM-6246-203	7/8 yd.	Cut 5 strips 5" wide for the third border.
9	Olive APTM-5574-49	1/2 yd.	Cut 5 strips 2-1/4" wide for the binding.

Construction Fans

1. Fold all Template A wedges in half lengthwise, right sides together and press. Sew across the wide end.

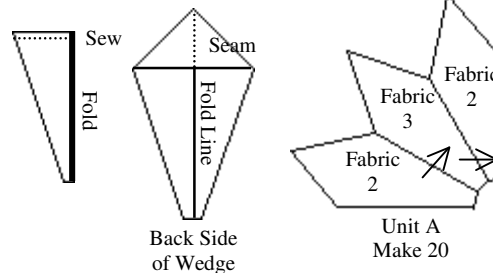
2. Turn the points right side out. Line up the seam with the press line and press flat. This will center the point.

3. Lay out the fan points as illustrated, and sew together to make 20 of Unit A and 16 of Unit B. Press the seams toward the arrows.

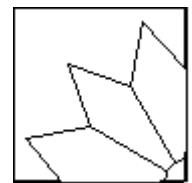
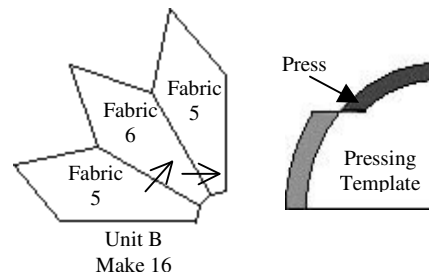
4. Lay the cardboard pressing template (make out of a light weight cardboard or manila folder) on the back of the Russet Template B. Spray starch the top edge seam allowance and press edge over the cardboard template.

5. Lay a Unit A on top of a 5-1/2" square of fabric 1 as illustrated. Machine or hand appliqué the fan to the 5-1/2" square. Make 20 of Section A. Repeat with Unit B to make 16 of Section B.

6. Place the Russet quarter circle on the fan as illustrated. Machine or hand appliqué the Russet quarter circle to the fan.



If the fan is too wide or too narrow adjust seam allowances slightly in equal increments across the fan until width is correct.



Block Construction

1. Lay a Section A Fan on both sides of a 2" x 5-1/2" rectangle

Make 2. Press toward arrows.

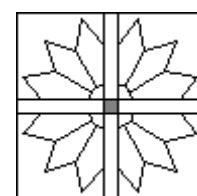
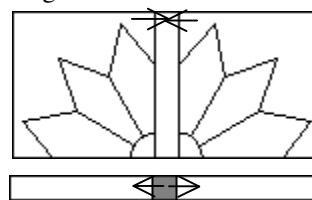
2. Sew a 2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of a 2" x 2" Russet square.

3. Sew into block as illustrated to make Block A.

Make 5 of Block A.

Repeat using Section B Fans. Make 4 of Block B.

4. Using the photo as a guide lay out the body of the quilt as illustrated.

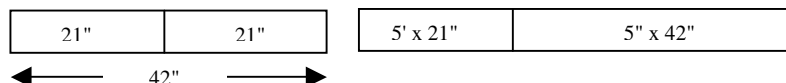
Borders (If your measurements are different, cut to your measurements)

1. Cut 2 of the 2" wide strips of fabric 7 down to measure 2" x 35". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Cut the 2 remaining 2" wide strips of fabric 7 down to measure 2" x 38". Sew to the sides of the quilt.

2. Cut 2 of the 1" wide strips of fabric 4 down to measure 1" x 38". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Cut the 2 remaining 1" wide strips of fabric 4 down to measure 1" x 39". Sew to the sides of the quilt.

3/ Cut 2 of the 5" wide strips of fabric 9 down to measure 5" x 39". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Cut one of the 5" wide strips of fabric 9 in half widthwise to make 2 strips 5" x 21". Sew a 5" x 21" strip to the end of the 2 remaining 5" wide strips of fabric 9 to make 2 strips 5" x 63". Cut the 2 strips down to measure 5" x 48". Sew to the sides of the quilt.

4. Layer Quilt and Bind.
