Finished quilt measures: $51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

twelve 9" squares

## From each of Fabrics B-G, cut:

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of each fabric

## From Fabric H, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 1-1/2" squares
Sew the remaining five strips together, then subcut:
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{\prime \prime}$ side middle borders
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom middle borders

## From Fabric I, cut:

eleven 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two $3^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
three 3 " $\times 37^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal sashing strips
eight $3^{\prime \prime} \times 11$ " vertical sashing strips
Sew the remaining four strips together, then subcut:
two 3 " $\times 50$ " side inner borders

## From Fabric J, cut:

six $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, then subcut:
two $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
two $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Arrange one $9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square, four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangles, and four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H squares in three rows of three as shown. Sew the squares and rectangles together to form rows. Press the seams towards the Fabric B rectangles. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press the seams towards the top and bottom of the block.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make a total of twelve blocks in the combinations shown below.


Assemble the Quilt
Step 3: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Separate the blocks in each row with a vertical sashing strip. Sew the blocks and vertical sashing strips together to form rows. Press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Step 5: Separate the rows with a horizontal sashingstrip. Sew the rows and horizontal sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Step 6: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle
 borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
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
