You will also need:
 2-3/4 yards fabric for Backing
 1/3 yard fabric for Binding
 54" x 54" batting

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

(Cut the fabrics according to the measurements below. Label each piece with their letter and number (A1, A2, A3...) or use a design wall to keep the pieces in order.)

Fabric A

- A1: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- A2: 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- A3: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- A4: 8-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- A5: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric B

- B1: 8-1/2" x 16-1/2"
- B2: 8-1/2" X 8-1/2"
- B3: 12-1/2" X 12-1/2"

Fabric C

- C1: 8-1/2" X 8-1/2"
- C2: 12-1/2" X 12-1/2"

Fabric D

- D1: 12-1/2" X 12-1/2"
- D2: 8-1/2" X 8-1/2"

Fabric E

- E1: 4-1/2" X 8-1/2"
- E2: 4-1/2" X 8-1/2"

Fabric F

- F1: 4-1/2" X 8-1/2"
- F2: 4-1/2" X 8-1/2"

Fabric G

- G1: 4-1/2" X 12-1/2"
- G2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric H

- H1: 4-1/2" 4-1/2"

Fabric I

- I1: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- I2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric J

- J1: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- J2: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Fabric K

- K1: 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- K2: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- K3: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric L

L1: Cut 2 strips 4-1/2" x WOF"
Stitch together lengthwise,
cut into one strip 4-1/2" x 48-1/2".

Fabric M

- M1: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- M2: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Fabric N

- N1: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric O

- O1: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric P

- P1: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- P2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric Q

- Q1: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- Q2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric R

- R1: 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- R2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- R3: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Fabric S

- S1: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- S2: 4-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Fabric T

- T1: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2"
- T2: 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Note: You will have fabric leftover - you can piece it together for your back or binding.

Assembly Instructions

Using the assembly diagram below as a map, stitch the quilt together in sections.

1. Section 1: Stitch C1 to M1, add P1, stitch D1 to I1, add to C1/M1/P1.
2. Section 2: Stitch T1 to F1, add N1, add B1.
3. Section 3: Stitch G1 to A1, stitch K1 to R1, stitch H1 to A2, stitch K1/R1 to H1/A2, then stitch K1/R1/H1/A2 to Q1, add B2, add G1/A1. Stitch E1 to J1, add O1, add F2. Stitch E1/J1/O1/F2 to G1/A1/B2/K1/R1/H1/A2/Q1.
4. Section 4: Stitch Q2 to A3, add C2. Stitch K2 to S1, add Q2/A3/C2.
5. Stitch section 3 to 4, add section 2, add section 1. Set aside.
6. Section 5: Stitch R2 to K3.
7. Section 6: Stitch D2 to R3, add M2, add A4, add B3. Stitch G2 to A5, add D2/R3/M2/A4/B3.
8. Section 7: Stitch S2 to T2, add E2, add J2.
9. Section 8: Stitch P2 to I2.
10. Stitch section 6 to 7, add section 5, add section 8.
11. Stitch section 1234 to L1, add section 5678.
12. Layer and quilt as desired. I quilted mine with large swirling shapes.
13. Bind the quilt with your favorite method.
