



## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

one 18-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 18-1/4" squares, then subcut each square along both diagonals to yield large setting triangles. You will have two extra triangles that are not needed.

one 9-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 9-3/8" squares, then subcut each square along one diagonal to yield small setting triangles.

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 5" squares.

seven 3" x WOF strips. Subcut

forty-eight 3" x 6" rectangles.

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 5" squares.

Trim two squares to 4-1/2".

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 5" squares.

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 4-1/2" squares.

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 4-1/2" squares.

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

five 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 6-1/2" x 51-1/2" side borders.

two 6-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom borders.

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 4-1/2" squares.

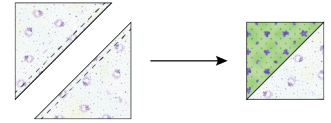
### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips.



## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

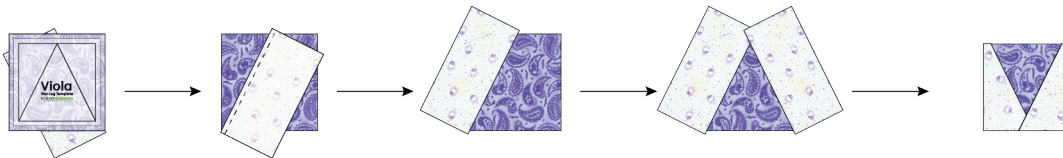
**Step 1:** Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight HSTs.



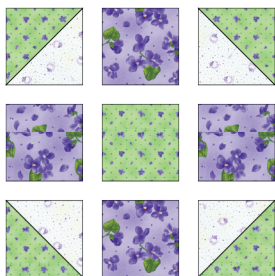
## Assemble the Star Leg Units

**Step 2:** Make twelve copies of page 7 to yield a total of twenty-four templates. Make sure they are copied at 100% scale. Cut the templates apart.

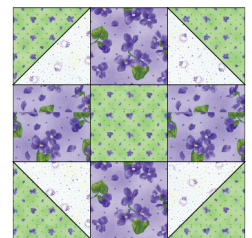
**Step 3:** Place one 5" Fabric C on the back side of a paper template. The wrong side of the fabric and the back side of the paper should be touching. Use a dab of glue or a pin to hold the square in place. Place a 3" x 6" Fabric A rectangle on top of the Fabric C square with right sides facing. Place the unit on a light box (or use a window) and adjust the placement of the rectangle until it is overhanging the seam line printed on the paper by about 1/4"-3/8". Use a dab of glue or a pin to hold the rectangle in place. Turn the unit paper side up and sew on the printed seam line. Ensure the Fabric A rectangle will cover the Fabric C beneath it when you fold the rectangle back, then trim the excess fabric 1/4" past the sewn seam. Repeat to add another Fabric A rectangle to the opposite side of the unit. Trim the unit around the outer line, then carefully remove the paper. Repeat to make twenty-four star leg units.



## Assemble the A Blocks

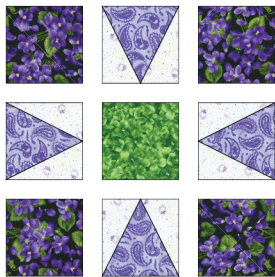


**Step 4:** Gather four HSTs, one Fabric B square, and four Fabric D squares. Arrange the pieces in three rows of three as shown. Sew the pieces together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric D squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make two A Blocks.

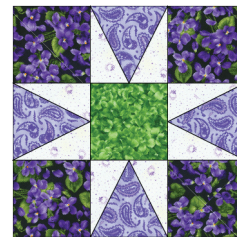




## Assemble the B Blocks

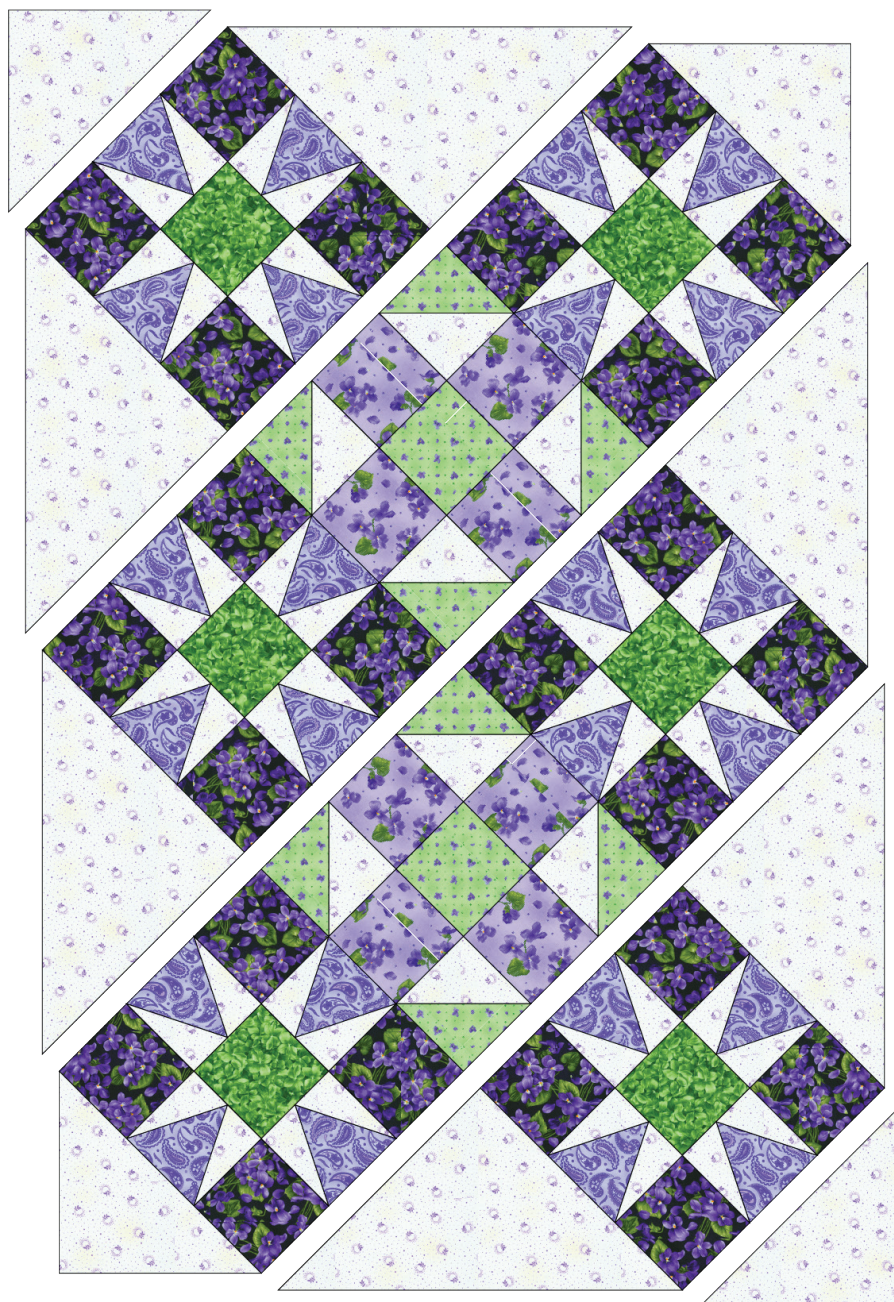


**Step 5:** Gather four star leg units, one Fabric E square, and four Fabric F squares. Arrange the pieces in three rows of three as shown. Sew the pieces together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric F squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make six B Blocks.

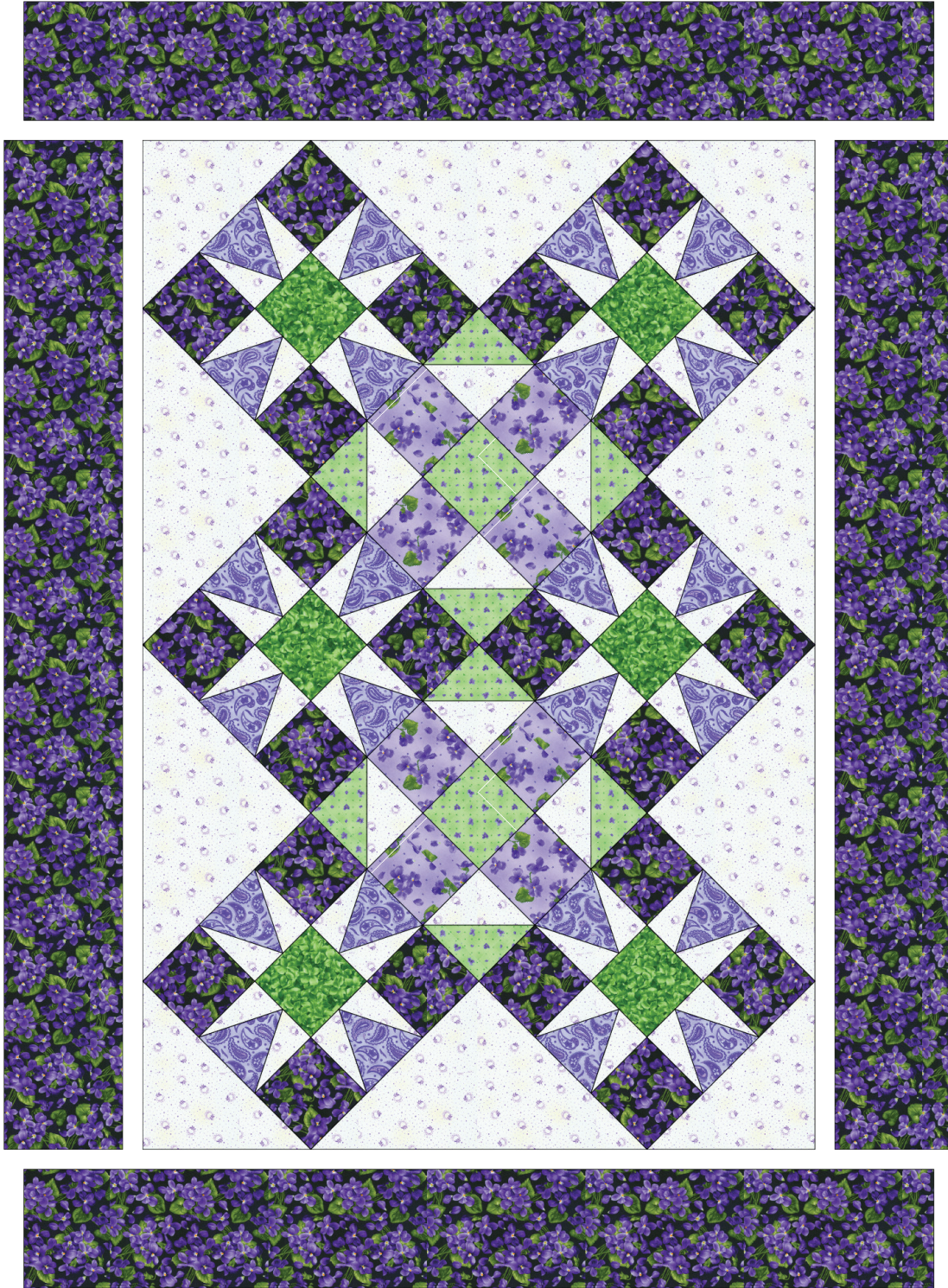


## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 6:** Arrange the blocks into *diagonal rows*. Add the setting triangles to your arrangement. Consult the Quilt Assembly Diagram below for block and setting triangle placement.







**Step 7:** Sew the blocks together to form diagonal rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

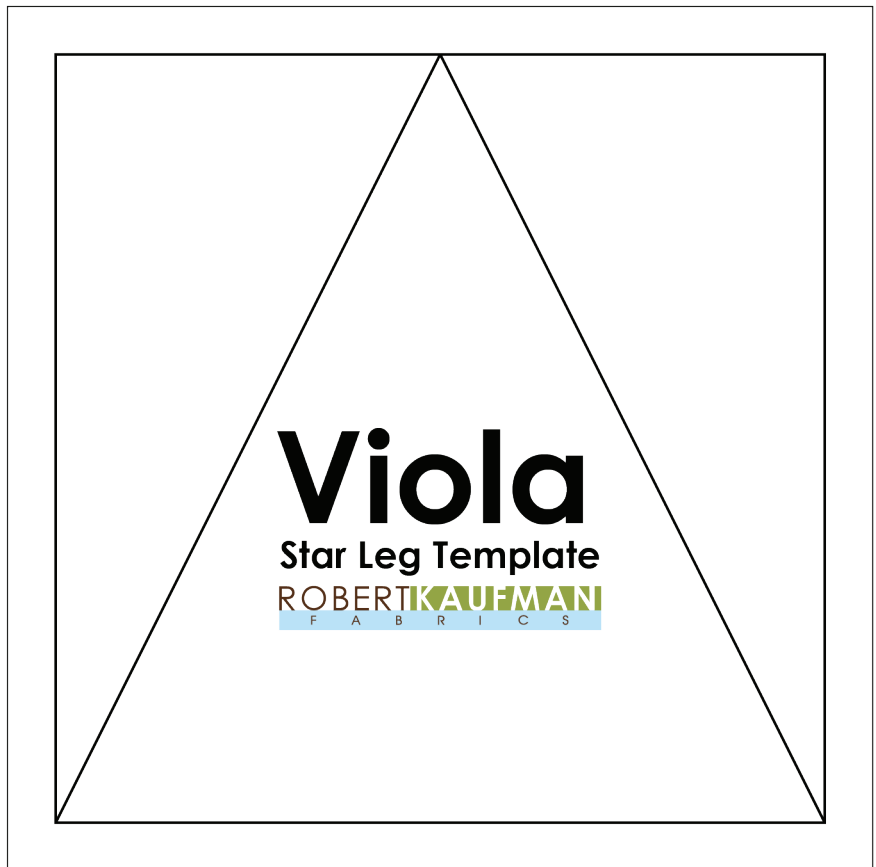
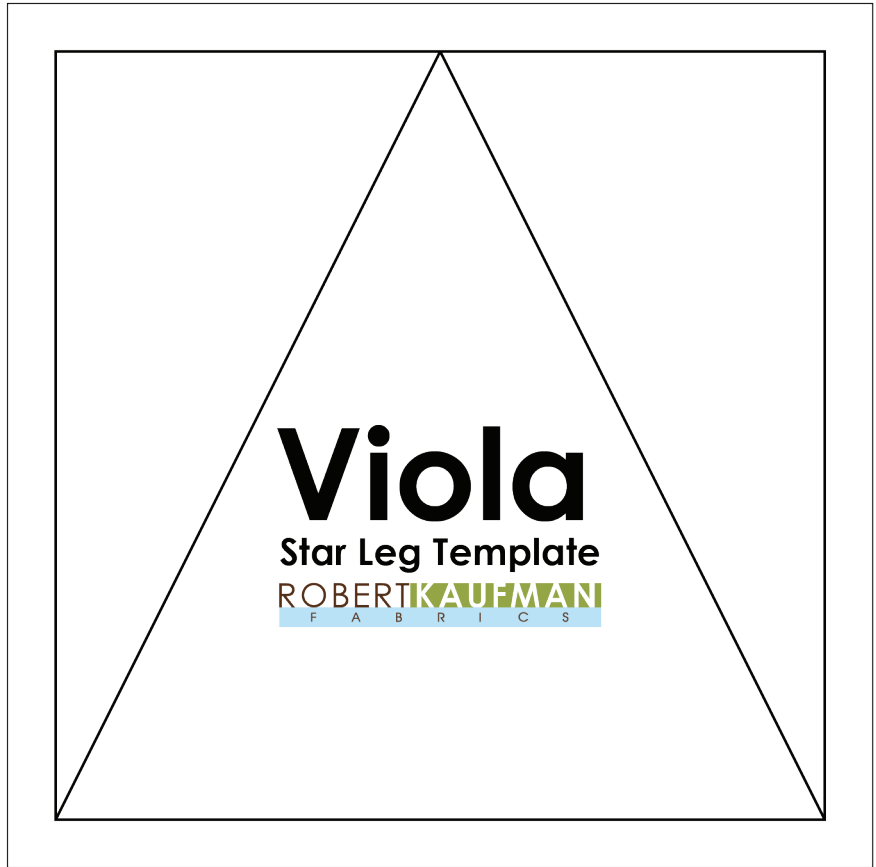
**Step 8:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open. If needed, measure 1/4" past the sewn points of the blocks and trim the quilt top square.

**Step 9:** Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

Print at 100%.
