

Finished quilt measures: 59-1/4" x 66-3/4"




Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

eleven 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ninety-seven 4-1/4" squares

thirty-six 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing

six 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-3/4" x 56-3/4" side inner borders

two 1-3/4" x 51-3/4" top/bottom inner borders

From each of Fabrics B-I and K-N, cut:

three 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

From Fabric J, cut:

six 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

four 4-1/4" x 59-1/4" strips for the outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Strip Pieced Blocks

Step 1: Gather:

two Fabric B strips

one Fabric A strip

Sew together along the longest edge, sewing the Fabric A strip between the B strips. Press away from the Fabric A strip. Cut the strip set into 1-3/4" wide units.



Step 2: Gather:
two Fabric A strips
one Fabric B strip

Sew together along the longest edge, sewing the Fabric B strip between the A strips. Press away from the Fabric A strips. Cut the strip set into 1-3/4" wide units.



Step 3: Gather:
two completed Step 1 units
one completed Step 2 units



Sew together, nesting the seams, to form a nine-patch unit. Press. The resulting block will measure 4-1/4" square. Make a total of eight Fabric B Blocks


Step 4: Repeat Steps 1-3 with the Fabric C-I and K-N strips to make a total of:



nine Fabric C Blocks



nine Fabric D Blocks




nine Fabric E Blocks

nine Fabric L Blocks




five Fabric M Blocks

Assemble the Quilt



Step 5: Arrange the Fabric A squares and nine-patch Blocks into fifteen rows of thirteen blocks. Follow the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, or arrange the nine-patch blocks in a random arrangement of your choosing.

Step 6: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 7: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 8: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
