




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### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:**

one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
two 10-1/2" x 9" rectangles of each fabric

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
two 10-1/2" x 19-1/2" rectangles.

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

eight 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four 2" x 19-1/2" top/bottom block borders  
twelve 2" x 13-1/2" side block borders  
eight 2" x 9" top/bottom block borders  
one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
twelve 1-1/2" squares

### **From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:**

four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty-eight 3" squares of each fabric for the HSTs

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
two 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles  
four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty-eight 3" squares for the HSTs  
seventeen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
four 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips  
four 2-1/2" x 35-1/2" strips  
six 2-1/2" 13-1/2" rectangles  
fourteen 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips  
forty-eight 2-1/2" squares  
six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty-eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

### **From Fabric H, cut:**

fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to make:  
seven 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" row sashing strips  
two 2-1/2" x 78-1/2" side sashing strips

### **From Fabric I, cut:**

three 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim the selvages sparingly to maximize yardage.  
Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to make:  
two 6-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips

### **From Fabric J, cut:**

eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to make:  
two 4-1/2" x 66-1/2" top/bottom outer borders  
two 4-1/2" x 86-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**  
 nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Framed Blocks



**Step 1:** Sew a 2" x 9" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of a 9" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press. Sew a 2" x 13-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press. The final block should measure 13-1/2" x 12".

Repeat to make four Small Framed Blocks this size using the Fabric A and B rectangles.



**Step 2:** Sew a 2" x 19-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the top and bottom of a 10-1/2" x 19-1/2" Fabric C rectangle. Press. Sew a 2" x 13-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left and right edges of the block. Press. The final block should measure 13-1/2" x 22-1/2".

Repeat to make two Larged Framed Blocks this size.

## Assemble the Pieced Blocks


**Step 3:** Pair a 3" Fabric E square with a 3" Fabric G square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make forty-eight E/G HSTs.



**Step 4:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



forty-eight F/G HSTs




forty-eight E/F HSTs

**Step 5:** Gather:

- one 2-1/2" Fabric G square
- one E/G HST
- one F/G HST
- one E/F HST

Sew together to form a four-patch, noting the fabric placement and block orientation in the diagram. Press the seams in opposite directions, then sew the rows together, nesting the seams. The resulting unit should measure 4-1/2" square.




Repeat to make forty-eight units like this.

**Step 6:** Gather:

- four complete Step 5 units
- one 1-1/2" Fabric D square
- four 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric G rectangles

Arrange the units into three rows of three.  
Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.




**Step 7:** Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams toward the fabric G strips.

**Step 8:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Block should measure 9-1/2" square. Repeat Steps 6-8 to make twelve Blocks.

### Assemble the Rows




**Step 9:** Gather:

- two Small Framed Blocks
- three Pieced Blocks
- four 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric G block sashing strips
- two 2-1/2" x 35-1/2" Fabric G strips
- two 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" Fabric G strips

Arrange the units as shown in the Row Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the seams toward the Fabric G strips.

This is Row 2. Repeat Step 9 to make Row 5.




**Step 10:** Gather:


- one Large Framed Block
- three Pieced Blocks
- three 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric G block sashing strips
- one 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric G rectangle
- two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" Fabric G strips
- one 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" Fabric G strips

Arrange the units as shown in the Row Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the seams toward the Fabric H strips.

This is Row 3. Repeat Step 10 to make Row 4, noting the difference in where the Framed Block is placed.



## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 11:** Arrange Rows 1-6 together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, taking care to ensure the blocks and rows are facing the correct direction. Sew each row together, using row sashing strips between each row and at the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press seams toward the sashing.

**Step 12:** Sew the side sashing strips to the side of the quilt center. Press.

**Step 13:** Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
