## Whoville Forest quilt featuring How the Grinch Stole Christmas fabrics by Dr. Seuss Enterprises

designed by Robert Kaufman Fabrics, instructions by Ramona Burke

Notes: use a 1/4 seam allowance throughout. Finished quilt measures 56-1/4" x 63"

## **Fabric Requirements**

Panel blocks	ADE-12605-223	2/3yd (one repeat)
Tree blocks	ADE-10791-38	3/4yd
Tree block background	ADE-10792-93	3/4yd
Border 1	ADE-10792-7	1/2yd
Border 2	ADE-12606-223	1/2yd
Border 3	ADE-12608-88	1-1/8yd
Binding	ADE-12607-2	1/2yd
Backing		4yds

## **Cutting Instructions**

- 1. Cut the (10) panel pieces into rectangles 7-1/2" x 11-1/4", and set them aside.
- 2. To make the "tree" blocks, cut (2) strips from the green polka dot fabric, 11-1/2" x WOF. Using the triangle template, (template PDF) cut (10) triangles. (extending the angled lines, as shown in pic1)



3. From the red stripe, cut a strip 12" x WOF. Cut (10) rectangles 4" x 12". Lay rectangles in pairs, right sides together, and cut the rectangles into triangles by slicing from one corner to the opposite.



4. Attach the red triangles to the green triangles, (press seam allowances to the red) to make a rectangle. Trim rectangles to match the panels.







5. Arrange blocks of panels and trees into rows as shown in the cover picture. Sew the rows together, pressing seam allowances toward the panel blocks. Sew the rows together into the quilt center. (center should measure 43.5" x 35.5")

- 6. Cut (5) strips for the first border from the green stripe at 3-1/2" x WOF. Piece the strips together into a long chain, pressing seams open. Sew the vertical borders first, then sew the borders along the top and bottom.
- 7. Cut (5) strips for the second border from the white print, 2-1/2" x WOF. Piece the strips together into a long chain, pressing seams open. Sew the vertical borders first, then sew the borders along the top and bottom.
- 8. Cut (6) strips for the third border from the blue print, 5-1/2" x WOF. Piece the strips together into a long chain, pressing seams open. Sew the vertical borders first, then sew the borders along the top and bottom.
- 9. Prepare a quilt back, quilt as desired, then cut 6 strips for the binding from the black print, 2-1/2" x WOF, and bind.
