## Difficulty Rating: Intermediate

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. From this, cut twelve of Template 1 and twelve of Template 1-Reversed.
three $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Set one strip aside for strip piecing. Subcut:

- twelve 4-1/2" squares
- two 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
seven $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Set two WOF strips aside for strip piecing. From the remaining strips, subcut:
- ten 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- twenty-four 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- ten 2-1/2" squares


## From Fabric B, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. From this, cut twenty-four of Template 1 and twenty-four of Template 1-Reversed.

## From Fabric C, cut:

one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. From this, cut twelve of Template 1 and twelve of
Template 1-Reversed.

## From Fabric D, cut:

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. From this, cut thirty-six of Template 1 and thirty-two of Template 1-Reversed.

## From Fabric E, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twenty-four 2-1/2" squares


## From Fabric F , cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twelve 2-1/2" squares


## From Fabric G, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strips piecing.

## From Fabric H , cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strips piecing.

## From Fabric I, cut:

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

- two 4-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
- two 4-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, or one $212^{\prime \prime}$ length of $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide bias binding.
Cover quilt shows bias binding.

Step 1: Sew the Template 1 and Template 1-Reversed pieces into units. Press the seam allowances in the direction indicated by the arrows.

Assemble the Strip Sets
Step 2: Sew strip sets as shown:
one 2-1/2" Fabric G and one 2-1/2" Fabric A strip, one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $H$ and one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip. Press. Cut each strip set into twelve $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide units.

Step 3: Sew strip sets as shown: one 2-1/2" Fabric H and one 4-1/2" Fabric A strip. Press. Cut each strip set into twelve 2-1/2" wide units.


## Assemble the Blocks

Step 4: Using the units from the previous steps and remaining cut pieces, sew the following blocks together. Press.



## Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the blocks into six columns of eight, as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew the blocks together to form the columns. Press the seams up in the even numbered columns and down in the odd numbered columns.


Step 6: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.


Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

## Templates

Print at 100\%.
Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.


## Suggested Tool:

The Tri Recs Tools ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ruler set is very helpful for accurately cutting multiple layers at a time. Use the 4-1/2" measurement on the ruler. Designed by Darlene Zimmerman .

Cutting 1 and 1 -Reversed (1-Reversed or mirror image of 1) to produce mirror image cuts: Cut 1 and 1 -Reversed from 4-1/2" wide strips. Fold the $4-1 / 2$ " wide strips right sides together. The diagrams will indicate if you need a WOF strip or half of a WOF strip. Use the Template 1 or Tri Rec ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ tool to cut strips into triangles. Stack the triangles.
