Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussycut:

two 13-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangles two 13-1/2" x 23-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" rectangles four 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangles Tip: cut one length of each of the above per WOF strip from four strips to maximize yardage. four 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangles four 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" rectangles four 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangles Tip: cut one length of each of the above per WOF strip from four strips to maximize yardage. four 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles four 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: one 5-1/2" x 50-1/2" strip

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" rectangles

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom inner borders two 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric E, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom middle borders two 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" side middle borders

From Fabric F, cut:

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 49-1/2" top/bottom outer borders two 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks


Step 1: Sew a 11-1/2" Fabric B strip to the sides of a 13-1/2" x 11-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press. Sew a 15-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press. Sew a 13-1/2" Fabric C strip to the sides of the block. Press. Sew a 17-1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press. The resulting block should measure 17-1/2" x 15-1/2". Repeat with the remaining Fabric A rectangle of this size.





Step 2: Sew a 23-1/2" Fabric C strip to the sides of a 13-1/2" x 23-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press. Sew a 15-1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press. Sew a 25-1/2" Fabric B strip to the sides of the block. Press. Sew a 17-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press. The resulting block should measure 17-1/2" x 27-1/2". Repeat with the remaining Fabric A rectangle of this size.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 3: Gather one block of each size and two 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabric D block sashing strips. Sew Column 1 together, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, placing a sashing strip between the blocks and at the bottom edge of the column. Press.

Step 4: Gather one block of each size and two 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabric D block sashing strips. Sew Column 2 together, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, placing a sashing strip between the blocks and at the top edge of the column. Press.

Step 5: Sew Columns 1 and 2 together, placing the 5-1/2" x 50-1/2" Fabric D strip between them. Press.

Step 6: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
