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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

two 11" x 19" large panel blocks four 11" x 9-1/2" small panel blocks

From Fabric B, cut:

sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew eleven strips together, end-to-end, then cut: six 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" row sashing strips two 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" side sashing strips
From the remaining five strips, subcut:

seven 2-1/2" 14-1/2" block sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 13" rectangles

two 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 11" rectangles

From Fabric D, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 11" rectangles

two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

four 6" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 6" x 69-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the remaining yardage, trim:

four 6" x length of fabric strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 6" x 66-1/2" side outer borders

From Fabric E, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

four 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/4" x 19" strips

four 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" strips

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

four 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

From Fabric G, cut:

three 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" rectangles

six 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

two 2" x 63-1/2" side inner borders

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 11" strips

two 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

four 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

From Fabric H, cut:

one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 11" strips

two 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

From Fabric I, cut:

three 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" rectangles

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 11" strips

two 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

four 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

From Fabric J, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5" x 51-1/2" strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a 2-1/4" x 19" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of a large Fabric A panel block. Press toward the strips. Sew a 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" Fabric F strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting Block should measure 14-1/2" x 22-1/2". Repeat to make a second Large Panel Block.



Step 2: Sew a 2-1/4" x 9-1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of a small Fabric A panel block. Press toward the strips. Sew a 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" Fabric I strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting Block should measure 13" x 14-1/2". Repeat to make a second Small Panel Block with Fabric I borders and two Small Panel Blocks with Fabric G borders.





Step 3: Sew a 1-1/2" x 11" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of a 4-1/2" x 11" Fabric C rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric G strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting Block should measure 6-1/2" x 13".

Repeat to make three more blocks like this, in the following fabric combinations:



(make two)



(make one)

Step 4: Sew a 1-1/2" \times 8-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of a 4-1/2" \times 8-1/2" Fabric D rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew a 1-1/2" \times 6-1/2" Fabric G strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting Block should measure 6-1/2" \times 10-1/2".



Repeat to make three more blocks like this, in the following fabric combinations:



(make two)



(make one)

Assemble the Rows

Row 1

Step 5: Gather:

one Large Panel Block

one Small Panel Block (with Fabric I borders)

two completed Step 3 blocks (referring to digram for fabric pairings)

two 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric B strips

one 2-1/2" x 13" Fabric B strip



Sew together to form the row, pressing the seams toward the Fabric B strips. Sew a Fabric B row sashing strip to the <u>top</u> of the row. Press.

Row 2

Step 6: Gather:

one Small Panel Block (with Fabric G borders)

one Small Panel Block (with Fabric I borders)

four completed Step 4 blocks (referring to digram for fabric pairings)

three 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric B strips

two 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric B strips



Sew together to form the row, pressing the seams toward the Fabric B strips.

Row 3

Step 7: Gather:

one Large Panel Block

one Small Panel Block (with Fabric G borders)

two completed Step 3 blocks (referring to digram for fabric pairings)

two 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric B strips

one 2-1/2" x 13" Fabric B strip



Sew together to form the row, pressing the seams toward the Fabric B strips. Sew a Fabric B row sashing strip to the <u>bottom</u> of the row. Press.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 8: Sew a Fabric B row sashing strip to the top and bottom of each of the Fabric J strips. Press.

Step 9: Arrange Rows 1-3 in order, placing a completed Step 8 unit between each row. Sew together and press.

Step 10: Sew the Fabric B side sashing strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press.

Step 11: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
