Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

From Fabric A, fussy cut: eight 9-1/2" x 11" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

two 11" x WOF strips. Subcut: eight 9-1/2" x 11" rectangles

#### From Fabric C, cut:

ten 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" sashing rectangles twenty 5-1/2" x 11" sashing rectangles

#### From Fabric D, cut:

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing. four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fifty 3" squares for the half-square triangles

#### From Fabric E, cut:

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing. four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fifty 3" squares for the half-square triangles

#### From Fabric F, cut:

three 7-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 7-1/2" x 61-1/2" top and bottom borders

#### From Fabric G, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" top and bottom outer borders two 3-1/2" x 87-1/2" side outer borders

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:


eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Churn Blocks


**Step 1:** Pair a Fabric D square with a Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make one hundred D/E HSTs.



**Step 2:** Sew a Fabric D and Fabric E strip together. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a total of four strip sets. (there will be one Fabric E strip left) Set two strip sets aside and cut the remaining two strip sets into a total of fifty 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" units.



**Step 3:** Sew the remaining E strip between the two strip sets left from Step 2, being sure to place the Fabrics in this order: E-D-E-D-E. Press toward the darker fabric. Cut the strip set into a total of twenty-five 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" units.




#### **Step 4:** Gather:

four Step 1 HSTs two Step 2 units one Step 3 unit

Arrange in three rows, as shown.

Sew the top and bottom rows together, pressing the seams away from the HSTs. Sew the top and bottom row to the middle (strip set) row. Press toward the middle row. Repeat to make twenty-five 5-1/2" Churn Blocks.



#### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 5:** Arrange the Fabric A and B rectangles together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using 5-1/2" x 11" sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

**Step 6:** Gather five Churn Blocks and four 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" sashing strips. Sew each row together, using Churn Blocks between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five sashing rows.

**Step 7:** Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 8:** Sew the Fabric F top and bottom borders to the quilt center, noting the orientation of the fabric.

**Step 9:** Sew the Fabric G top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
