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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

four 16-1/2" squares.

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles. eight 1-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles. four 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

From each of Fabrics C-E, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 2-1/2" squares of each fabric. Trim the remainder of the strip to 1-7/8". Subcut: eight 1-7/8" squares of each fabric.

From Fabric F, cut:

twenty-two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-eight 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles.
six 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.
seventy-two 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
twenty-four 1-1/2" squares.

From Fabric G, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fourteen 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles.
three 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
twelve 2-1/2" squares.
two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 1-1/2" squares.

From Fabric H, cut:

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 5-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Large Blocks

Step 1: Gather one 16-1/2" Fabric A square, two 1-1/2" \times 16-1/2" Fabric B rectangles, and two 1-1/2" \times 18-1/2" Fabric B rectangles. Sew the two 1-1/2" \times 16-1/2" rectangles to the left and right edges of the square. Press the seams towards the rectangles. Sew the 1-1/2" \times 18-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom edges of the unit. Press the seams towards the rectangles. Repeat to make four large blocks.



Assemble the Star Blocks

Step 2: Pin two 1-7/8" Fabric C squares in opposing corners of a 3-1/4" Fabric F square, RST. The squares will overlap slightly in the center of the large square. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the squares.



Step 3: Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set the seam by pressing it flat. Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.



Step 4: Press the fabric toward smaller triangles. Repeat with the second unit.



Step 5: Place one 1-7/8" Fabric C square at the corner of a sewn block unit. Draw a diagonal line in pencil. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Set seam (press). Cut along the diagonal line, creating two identical units.



Step 6: Press the seam toward the smaller triangle. Trim off small dog ears left by the seam allowance. Trim to 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" if necessary.



Step 7: Gather one 2-1/2" Fabric C square, four 1-1/2" Fabric F squares, and the four flying geese. Arrange the pieces in three rows of three to form a star. Sew the pieces together to form rows, then press the seams towards the squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a second Fabric C Star Block.



Step 8: Repeat Steps 2-7 to make:



two Fabric D Star Blocks



two Fabric E Star Blocks

Assemble the Sashing Strips

Step 9: Gather four 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric F rectangles, four 1-1/2" Fabric G squares, and one 2-1/2" Fabric G square. Arrange the pieces in three rows of three as shown. Sew the pieces together to form rows, then press the seams towards the darker fabric. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make twelve small sashing units.



Step 10: Gather two 1-1/2" \times 6-1/2" Fabric F rectangles and one 2-1/2" \times 6-1/2" Fabric G rectangle. Sew the Fabric F rectangles to the long edges of the Fabric G rectangle, then press the seams towards the darker fabric. Repeat to make three medium sashing units.



Step 11: Gather two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric F rectangles and one 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric G rectangle. Sew the Fabric F rectangles to the long edges of the Fabric G rectangle, then press the seams towards the darker fabric. Repeat to make fourteen large sashing units.




Step 12: Gather three small sashing units from Step 9 and two large sashing units from Step 11. Alternate between small and large units to form a row. Sew the sashing units together to form the row, then press the seams towards the small units. Repeat to make four horizontal sashing strips.



Assemble the Large Block Rows

Step 13: Gather two Large Blocks from Step 1 and three large sashing units from Step 11. Alternate between sashing units and blocks to form a row. Sew the row together, then press the seams towards the blocks. Repeat to make a second Large Block Row.



Assemble the Star Block Row

Step 14: Gather one Fabric C Star Block, one Fabric D Star Block, one Fabric E Star Block, and four 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric F rectangles. Alternate between rectangles and blocks to form a row. Sew the row together, then press the seams towards the sashing strips.



Step 15: Gather two 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric B rectangles and two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric B rectangles. Sew the 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left and right edges of the Step 14 unit. Press the seams towards the rectangles. Sew the 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of the unit, then press the seams towards the rectangles. Repeat to make a second star unit.



Step 16: Gather three medium sashing units from Step 10. Alternate between sashing units and the star units from Step 15 to form a row. Sew the row together, then press the seams towards the star units.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 17: Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram to layout the quilt top. Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the seams away from the horizontal sashing strips.

Step 18: Sew two border strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the two remaining border strips to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
